| A robust plant with tough silvery grey leaves that are frost, wind and<br>salt resistant. Fragrant flowers in the autumn and orange fruits in<br>the spring. | A dense, slow-growing, evergreen with glossy, dark green leaves<br>beautifully offset by highly scented, jasmine like, white flowers in<br>mid and late spring.
